## **2008 Visiting Dissertation Scholars- Fellowships for Graduate U.S. Minorities in Humanities, Social Sciences, Business, and Other Fields**

This informal Consortium of colleges and universities in the Northeast aims to increase the number of U.S. citizen African Americans, Mexican Americans, Puerto Rican Americans, and Native Americans who enter the professoriate. Each Consortium campus will bring one or more dissertation-level, under-represented minority graduate students to its campus for 12 months to devote substantial time to the completion of their dissertation and become acquainted with their host campus and department. Visiting scholars will be provided with \$25,000- \$32,000, computer and library privileges, office space, health insurance, and a faculty liaison. The application deadline is Feb. 1, 2008.
