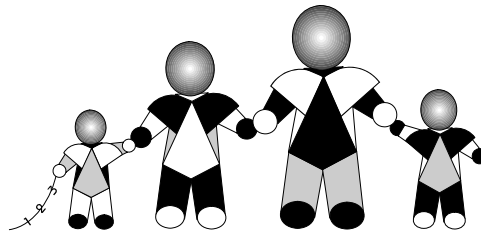


FAMILY MATH TRAINING REGISTRATION FORM

FAMILY MATH training prepares educators to establish and conduct **FAMILY MATH** classes at their schools. These classes include materials and activities for parents to use in helping their children with mathematics; these classes may be conducted in English or Spanish.

FAMILY MATH training provides 18 hours of professional development. The Center for Family Involvement in Schools (NJDOE Provider #1660) and the Rutgers Center for Mathematics, Science, and Computer Education (NJDOE Provider #2), which sponsor the training workshops, are registered as professional development providers with the New Jersey Department of Education.

FAMILY MATH training will include:

- ✓ Math activities for use with parents and children from all elementary math skill and concept areas.
- ✓ Career activities that demonstrate the importance of mathematics in children's futures.
- ✓ Information on how to set up **FAMILY MATH** classes.
- ✓ One copy of the **FAMILY MATH** **book and other materials necessary to conduct **FAMILY MATH** classes. (The books and materials are provided in **English** or **Spanish**. Please indicate your preference below, and add \$25.00 to the fee per additional book you wish to order.)
