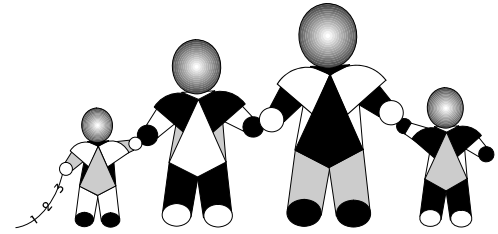




Family Math II

Each day of training will include 3-5 new activities from the Family Math II book.
