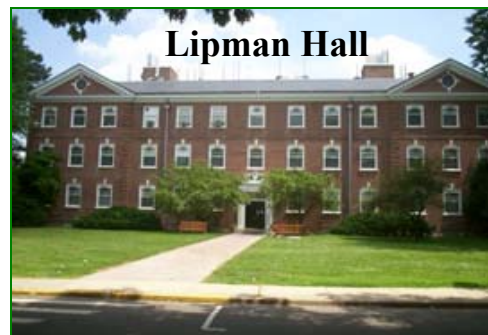

Airport Information

Newark International Airport (Code EWR) is the closest airport to Rutgers University, about a 40-minute train or car ride to New Brunswick, NJ. Philadelphia International Airport (code PHL) is about 1¼ hours from Rutgers, but there is no direct train route to New Brunswick.

Train Information

If coming from New York City or Newark Airport, take the NJ Transit Northeast Corridor Line train and exit at the New Brunswick station. You can then order a taxi to your hotel (see taxi info, below), or take the EE campus bus (free of charge) directly to Lipman Hall or to the University Inn (see below), if you are staying there.

Bus Directions: When you depart the train, turn right and walk to the end of the ramp and down the stairs, to the corner of Somerset and George Streets. The campus bus stop is on the same side of the street as the stairs. Take only the EE bus!

Hotel Information

As for hotels, the closest one to the course site is the [University Inn and Conference Center](http://www.csc.cba.rutgers.edu/UniversityInn).

The University Inn is only about a 5 to 10 minute walk to the course site, Lipman Hall. For all other hotels, you will need to take a taxi or rental car to the course site.

Directions via Campus Bus: if coming from the New Brunswick train station, take the EE bus to the “Katzenbach” stop. After exiting the bus, walk in the direction so the road is on your right side. The driveway to the Inn will be on your left. Directions via car: call the hotel number and follow the voice prompt to obtain driving directions.
