If you have declared a major please meet with your faculty advisor for questions regarding requirements for the major. For questions concerning your distribution or proficiency requirements please see Dean Trivedi in 104 College Hall.

If you have not declared a major you will be expected to do so as soon as possible. You can also contact your class year Dean for a referral to a faculty member in the department in which you wish to major. To determine if you have done everything necessary to get yourself on the right track. . .

- Check your e-mail (eden account) and DPO on a regular basis.
- Are you carrying sufficient credits? By the end of this term you should have about 75 credits to be on schedule for graduation.
- Have you registered for courses to complete your degree distribution requirements?
- Have you satisfied the English, Math, and Language proficiency requirements?
- Review your transcript to see if you have repeated a course in which you received a "D." If so, did you file a "D" form? If not, please stop by 104 College Hall to do so. **Remember that you will receive credit only once when you repeat a "D."**
- If you retook a course that you previously failed, did you file a repeat form? If not, please stop by 104 College Hall to do so.
- Make certain that you have not taken/are not taking a course for which you already have transfer credit. **You will receive credit only once for a given course.**
- If you are on academic probation please follow the instructions contained in the letter you received from the Student Academic Affairs Committee.
