Eligibility:

- DRC student or affiliate engaging in a S.T.E.M. summer research project
- Completion of two years of academic work or practicum experience with a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.8 or better
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident or visa status eligible to receive a summer stipend (visa holders must provide verification of eligibility)

Completed application packets should include:

- Application form
- Resume
- Brief statement (250 words) describing the internship and the nature of the research involved
- Transcript (unofficial)
- Letter of support from research sponsor outlining:
 - your role in the lab and/or project
 - amount of matching funds (if applicable)
 - number of weeks and hours per week you will be working
 - how your internship fits into the larger context of her/his research
 - how your performance will be evaluated

Terms of stipend agreement:

- Completion of a minimum of 200 research hours documented by the sponsoring individual
- Sponsor must provide proof of IRB compliance if applicable
- Submission of a 3-5 page summary report (September 11, 2009)
- Participation in the Undergraduate Research Poster Session (September 25, 2009)
