

NJ PLACE Evaluation of Transfer Credits Form

NJ Pathways Leading Apprentices to a College Education (NJ PLACE) is a program that recognizes registered apprenticeship training programs as a pathway to college and awards college credits toward Associate in Applied Science in Technical Studies degree programs at New Jersey's 19 community colleges.

NJ PLACE students who have completed their apprenticeship training program need to:

- A. Complete an application for admission to one of NJ's 19 community colleges and enroll in its Associate in Applied Science in Technical Studies degree program.
- B. Complete this NJ PLACE Evaluation of Transfer Credits Form that requests the US Department of Labor's Office of Apprenticeship to provide a letter verifying the apprentice's registration or completion of apprenticeship directly to the community college.
- C. Complete the community college request for transfer credit evaluation and pay the evaluation fee, if applicable.
